#### Motorcyclist killed in crash in rural **Faulkner** County

A Jacksonville motorcyclist was killed in a crash in rural Faulkner County on Saturday. Michael W. Lucas, 57, was stopped at the intersection of U.S. Highway 64 and Rooster Road before 4 p.m. on Saturday when a 2019 Chevrolet struck his 2010 Harley Davidson "in the rear," a fatal crash summary issued by the Arkansas Department of Public Safety read.

No one else was injured in the collision. Weather and road conditions were "clear" and "dry" at the time of the crash, the summary read.
