as a Coalition

And voters just couldn't care less

The Coalition's embarrassing split over infighting that played out like a lousy soap opera in front of the nation has ended after a mere

17 days. Opposition Leader Sussan Ley on Sunday announced the Liberals and Nationals would reunite, admitting the messy separation had been a "difficult" time for the parties' backers.

But the damage from the break-up appears to have been done, with latest polling revealing its primary vote had plummeted to just 18 per cent, while Ms Ley has become the least popular

major party leader in more than two decades.

And One Nation has enjoyed another surge in support, now at 27 per cent, behind Labor's 33 per cent.

Nationals leader David Littleproud walked away from the Coalition last month after a disagreement over new hate speech laws.
