# Police cameras get more funding

### Federal grant gives officials more than \$1 million to expand project across city

Torrance has received \$1.03 million in federal funding to add cameras across the city and increase broadband radio connectivity for the Police Department. The city originally asked for

\$2 million from Rep. Ted Lieu, D-Los Angeles, but only received part of the requested amount through the FY26 Commerce, Justice and Science Appropriations bill recently signed into law.

The original request would have used the money for 100 additional cameras and to install

five more citizen broadband radio system sites throughout the city. The Police Department has not yet determined if it will scale down the project or seek additional funding from other sources.

The effort, dubbed the Public Safety Digital Infrastructure Modernization project, is intended to expand on the city's current Real Time Response

# Rob Reiner's son pleads not guilty

### Arraignment on murder charges marks first time he's denied killing parents

LOS ANGELES — Nick Reiner, the 32-year-old son of Hollywood luminary Rob Reiner and Michele Singer Reiner, pleaded not guilty Monday to two counts of first-degree murder more than two months after their deaths, denying for the first time that he fatally stabbed his parents.

Reiner's attorney, Deputy Public Defender Kimberly Greene, entered the plea on his behalf as he stood behind glass in an enclosed custody area of the packed Los Angeles courtroom.

The third of Rob Reiner's four children, Nick Reiner has been held without bail since his arrest hours after beloved actor-director Reiner and photographer and

# Violence follows killing of drug lord

### 25 troops die in attacks after military operation

GUADALAJARA, Mexico — Twenty-five members of the Mexican National Guard died in six separate attacks after special forces killed the notorious leader of the Jalisco New Generation Cartel, the country's security secretary said Monday as much of Mexico feared more violence.

Nemesio Oseguera Cervantes, called "El Mencho," was the boss of one of the fastest-growing criminal networks in Mexico, known for trafficking fentanyl, methamphetamine and cocaine to

# Kaiser strike ends as parties report progress in talks

The nearly five-week strike by 31,000 registered nurses and other workers at Kaiser Permanente is over, with union members set to return to work today.

In a statement, the union said its members are going back to work while "final negotiations are completed."

The likely end of the protracted walkout comes after last week saw more than 40% of union workers cross picket lines and go back to work.

With town hall and video conferencing meetings scheduled Monday, the union posted a message via
