# Businesses in limbo after crash

### Weeks after vehicle rammed building, owners, employees wait for inspection

On June 21, Azusa resident Michael Delgado was enjoying a Father's Day brunch with his in-laws when he got a call any business owner dreads. Around 10 a.m., Delgado's landlord called to inform him

a car had crashed through the building at Delgado's business. Delgado owns Happy Paws Dog Grooming in Monrovia, where he's been providing grooming services for over a decade. The large car, which appears to be a Jeep or a truck from videos the business posted on

Instagram, most directly hit neighboring Devine Hair. The cause of the collision is still under investigation, according to the Monrovia Police Department. No arrests have been made as of July 2, according to Monrovia Lt. Richard Schneider. Officials declined to give more detail about the car or driver, citing an ongoing investigation.

# 'The Pitt' has 25 nods to lead Emmys roster

## 'Hacks' sets record for comedies with 24 nominations in HBO coup

LOS ANGELES — "The Pitt" led all nominees with 25 in a dominant sophomore season, while "Hacks" got a graduation party with a record-setting 24 to lead all comedies in its final season as Emmy nominations were announced Wednesday.

The totals give HBO Max the top spot for both drama and comedy, with "Hacks" breaking the record for most nominations for a comedy series held jointly by "The Studio" last year and "The Bear" in 2024. HBO Max led all outlets with 122 overall nominations and has three shows up for both best drama and best comedy series.

The nominees announced for

# U.S. hits more targets in Iran

### Ceasefire in tatters as strikes follow attacks on ships in strait

DUBAI, United Arab Emirates — The U.S. carried out another round of strikes on Iran Wednesday, hours after President Donald Trump said that recent Iranian attacks on ships in Strait of Hormuz signaled the end of the ceasefire.

Military officials said in a social media post that the strikes were intended to "further degrade" Iran's ability "to threaten freedom of navigation" in the strait.

The action comes just a day after the U.S. military hit a variety of military sites and port facilities following Iran's targeting of several merchant

More than 25 Los Angeles-based artists will come together for "Art for Venezuela," a benefit exhibition and art sale to raise funds for Hogar Bambi Venezuela, a nonprofit that protects and cares for the country's vulnerable children.

Since two deadly earthquakes hit northern Venezuela on June 24, killing at least 3,535, artists have been organizing in myriad ways to help an
