Doctors work to help Gaza hospital rebuilding

Doctors Against Genocide has raised more than \$400,000 to expand Shifa Hospital in Gaza as hospitals in the region struggle to keep up with the ongoing humanitarian crisis.

Israel invaded Gaza City's Shifa Hospital in November 2023 and March 2024, saying Hamas worked in the area, a claim Hamas denied. Medical professionals have continued to work out of the seriously damaged facility. As of Aug. 12, Shifa Hospi-

Florida plan to drop vaccine requirements sparks worry

Eliminating vaccine requirements in Florida will effectively strip protections against infectious diseases for all ages, but especially vulnerable children and elders, according to medical professionals reacting to a plan unveiled by state leaders.

Gov. Ron DeSantis and state Surgeon General Joseph Ladapo announced their intent Sept. 3 that Florida will become the first state to eliminate vaccine mandates.

The state Legislature would have to support repealing some of the requirements while the state Department of Health, which Ladapo heads, has leeway on others.

Both DeSantis and Ladapo have backed the anti-vax movement since the COVID-19 pandemic when getting the shot was required by many states and businesses during the height of the epidemic and later halted.

What did Southwest Florida medical leaders say?

Leaders at hospitals to pediatricians serving the neediest children issued statements of caution to outright alarm about the potential impact of vaccine requirements that have been embedded for decades in daily life going away.

In contrast, the Collier County School District said it does not respond to proposals or pending legislation.

Lee School District spokesman Rob

learning of the shooting. By late afternoon, news organizations and President Donald Trump were saying Kirk had died.


"No one understood or had the Heart of the Youth in the United States of America better than Charlie," Trump posted on his Truth Social account. "He was loved and admired by ALL,
