

Catholic school opening this fall in Framingham

FRAMINGHAM — A new Catholic, co-educational high school is set to open in September, seven years after the closure of Framingham’s last co-ed Catholic high school, Marian High School. Chesterton Academy of the Immaculata is opening its doors this fall. The school will focus on a classical education. The school’s board of directors chair, Nathalie Calvo, said families in MetroWest wanted an option for their children to continue a co-educational Catholic education. “Their kids were in Catholic school for elementary and middle school, and they really wanted to continue that,” Calvo, who also sits on the board of St. Benedict Classical Academy in Natick, told the Daily News during an interview at the school’s Clinton Street campus. “When they came upon the Chesterton network, it was really answered prayers.”

Children’s Museum of Franklin sets opening date

The Children’s Museum of Franklin is set to open their doors on Thursday, Sept. 18, bringing a new educational and enjoyable experience to the region. Located at 157 Cottage St. in Franklin, formerly home to Agway, Franklin residents and close friends Erin Gallagher and Meg Hagen founded the museum. They hope to create a space where children and families can learn, play, and create community. “We see this as a space where kids and families can come in and discover and grow and explore but also build community for themselves and the caregivers that are in the space,” Gallagher said. To celebrate its grand opening, the museum will host several events, including a ribbon-cutting ceremony on Sept. 17.

World’s deadliest animal is buzzing around the back yard right now

What’s the world’s most dangerous animal? Hint: It’s plentiful in the summer in Massachusetts and no, it’s not a coyote or a bear. According to the Centers for Disease Control, the deadliest animal in the world is the mosquito. “The mosquito kills more people than any other creature in the world,” the CDC said. It kills over 725,000 people a year through diseases like malaria, dengue, West Nile Virus (WNV), eastern equine encephalitis (EEE), yellow fever, Zika and chikungunya. The Massachusetts Department of Health said there are 51 types of mosquitoes in the state, some of which transmit WNV and EEE. The agency tracks mosquito-borne illnesses, known as arboviruses, and shows the risk factor in your area. Here’s what you should know, including how you can protect yourself and your family.
