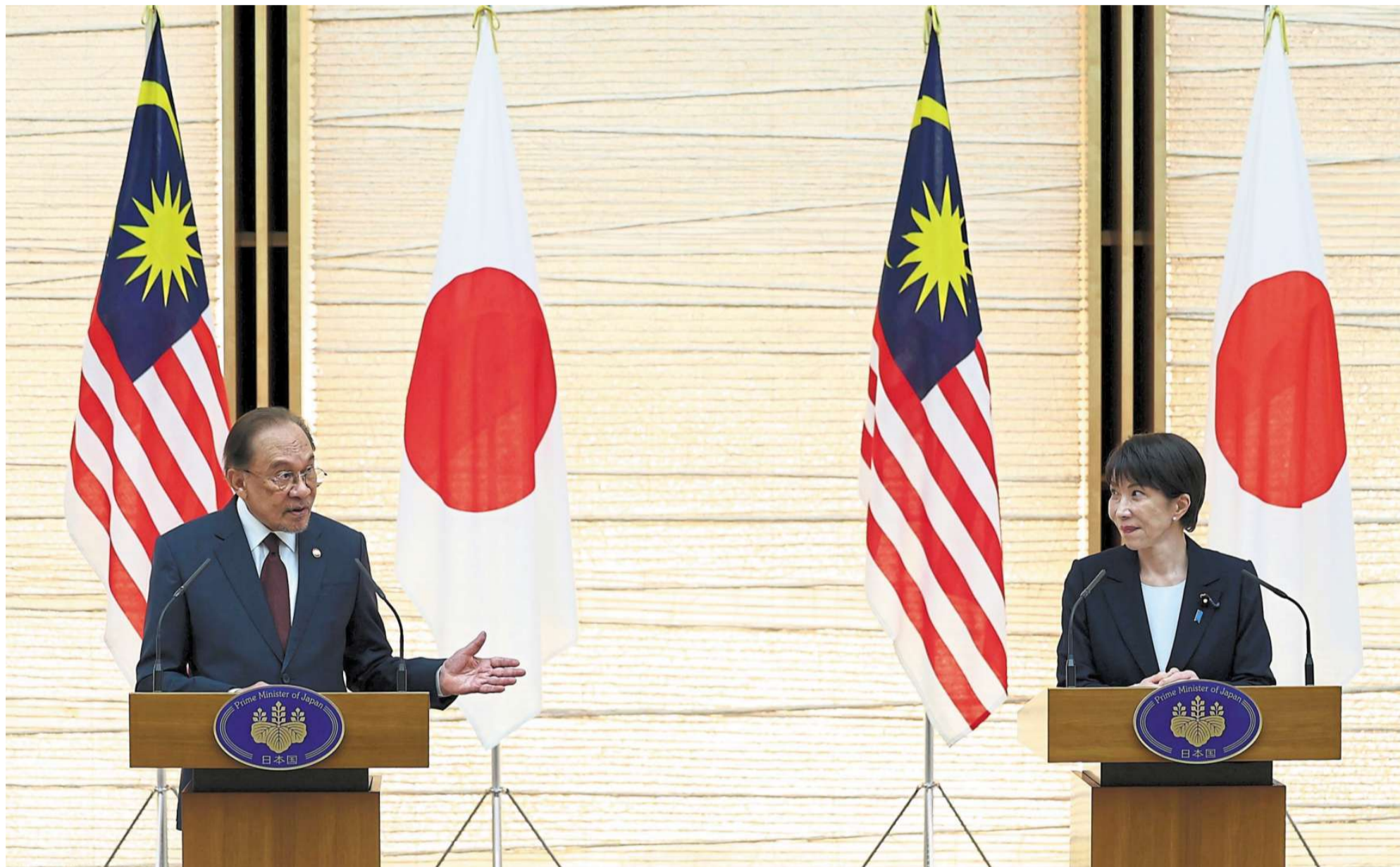




## High-tech push in Tokyo
