HOLLAND — While much of the shoreline remains locked in cold air, the steady movement of water shows the season is beginning to change.

Ice continued to shift and thin along the lakeshore as unseasonable warmth spread through West Michigan in mid-February. At Holland State Park, chunks

of ice drifted through the channel connecting Lake Michigan and Lake Macatawa, signaling the slow transition from deep winter toward early thaw.

Though spring remains weeks away, the gradual break up of ice offers a visible reminder that winter won't last forever.
