PROVIDENCE, RI – On a recent weekday morning, the alert went out around 9 a.m.

Three U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement vehicles were spotted near Garrahy Judicial Complex in downtown Providence, Rhode Island.

A pair from the Deportation Defense

Network of Rhode Island's College Hill group quickly sprung into action, pursuing one of the vehicles on bicycles and reporting back to the larger group as they tracked it onto the highway. Another volunteer tapped on another vehicle's window and asked if they were law enforcement officers – to which they got no response.

Yet another volunteer described getting "weird eye contact" from one of the officers and a quick "Bye, see you tomorrow" – words the group viewed as a typical ICE "scare tactic."

"We saw ICE and now they're gone," said Caroline Cordts, leader of the group's 8:30 to 10:30 a.m. shift.

For three weeks, volunteers have been patrolling the streets near courthouses in Providence every weekday on the lookout for ICE agents.

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Howell postpones vote on tax break for apartments

HOWELL — A low-income senior apartment complex is seeking a tax exemption from Howell City Council to fund upgrades, but officials are hesitant to approve the proposal as-is.

Ethos Development Partners is requesting a 4% PILOT (Payment in Lieu of Taxes) through the Michigan State Housing Development Authority's Low Income Housing Tax Credit Program for Country Glen at 600 Warbler Way.

The program exempts eligible housing units from standard property taxes, allowing the owner to pay a reduced "PILOT" fee instead. Country Glen Apartments is seeking an exemption to offset improvements across 32 apartments, including repaving the parking lot and new landscaping, roofing, windows, patio doors, accessible restrooms, AC units, baseboard heating, electrical and high-efficiency boilers — in addition to updated kitchens, bathrooms and common areas.

The total income earned by the complex after subtracting vacancy loss and utilities is \$386,076, according to meeting documents. Through the PILOT, Howell would receive an annual payment of \$15,443.

The apartments are listed below market-rate. According to the applicant, 30 one-bedroom units are \$1,150 per month and two one-bedroom units are \$1,035 per month.

During a meeting of Howell City Council on Oct. 13, the proposal initially failed because no councilmember was willing to put forth a motion. Later in the meeting, City Attorney Sarah

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Detroit Wing Co. closes after three years

Detroit Wing Co. has reportedly closed after three years at 118 W. Highland Road in Howell.

The brand opened a location in Crossroads Town Center in June 2022. Detroit Wing Co. is known for wings, sandwiches, fries, macaroni and cheese, sides and desserts. A nearby location in Brighton at 8593 W. Grand Riv-

er Ave. closed in May 2023 about a year after opening.

The location in Howell is no longer listed on the brand's official website, and is listed as permanently closed on Google and closed on Yelp. There are now 23 locations remaining, including 22 in Michigan and one in Lorain, Ohio.

Detroit Wing Co. didn't immediately respond to a request for comment from The Daily.

The nearest remaining locations can be found in Lansing, East Lansing, Novi

and Livonia. Learn more at detroitwing-co.com.
