HARTLAND — Hartland Village got a whole lot sweeter with the opening of Greenhouse Bakery on June 20. Hannah Green recently opened the bakery at 3620 Avon St. — the former home of Hartland Village Pizza & Custard. She spent about seven months renovating after taking over the space in November 2025. Green has long wanted to open a bakery, she told The Daily. With her children getting older, she said, the timing felt right to turn her dream into a business. The bakery carries cupcakes, macarons, cookies, eclairs, brownies, muffins and other pastries. Green rotates flavors regularly, though staples like the business’ bestselling chocolate chip cookies are always available. Greenhouse Bakery also has a free community library, where visitors can leave or borrow books covering a variety of genres for all ages. Green has enjoyed joining the business community and serving customers where she lives, she told The Daily. “I’ve been much busier than I expected to be,” she said. “It’s been amazing.”

diving. For your planning pleasure, here’s five of our best recommendations for exploration:
Spring Mill Pond
Spring Mill Pond is located inside Island Lake Recreation Area at 6301 Kensington Road in Brighton. The pond is a cool, clear swimming spot fed by natural

springs, according to Explore Brighton Howell Area. Families can spend the day swimming, grilling or relaxing at picnic tables. The site also includes sand volleyball courts, vending machines and restrooms. Interesting in fishing? The pond is stocked with brown and rainbow trout.
