Nebraskan started selling ‘grief cards’ after a string of crushing tragedies

Angie Hanson started the morning the same as every other work day. She took her 1-year-old son, Garret, to day care, gave him a kiss and a hug,

told him she’d see him later that day, then headed to work.

Hours later came a phone call delivering every parent’s worst nightmare. Garret wouldn’t wake up from his nap.

Garret’s death on June 27, 2006, was the first of a trio of tragedies that would upend life for Hanson and her family. Her son died, then her
