BJ Roasters takes top honors

Millville restaurant chosen by readers as their favorite wing spot in South Jersey

People are gearing up for Super Bowl LX, scheduled for Feb. 8 at Levi's Stadium in Santa Clara, California, where the New England Patriots are to face the Seattle Seahawks.

BJ Roasters in Millville is a South Jersey landmark that sells plenty of wings for the Super Bowl and all year-round. And this popular eatery, which was established in February of 1994, finished atop the 2026 Courier-Post poll for being the favorite wing spot in South Jersey, according to readers.

BJ Roasters took home 30% of the votes, 332 votes overall, topping Dominic's Tavern in Bellmawr (27%), Pic-A-Lilli Inn in Shamong (11%), Golden Nugget Tavern in Berlin (7%) and Jug Handle Inn in Cinnaminson (7%).

"I am so honored to have won the poll," BJ Roasters owner Julia Pacitto said in an email response to the Courier-Post.

Former TD Bank worker moved over \$5.5M out of the country

Money-laundering plea marks 3rd this year

A second employee of T.D. Bank N.A. has admitted to taking part in a money-laundering scheme for a Colombian drug ring.

Leonardo Ayala, who worked at a TD Bank office in Doral, Florida, accepted bribes worth more than \$6,000 in return for helping to move more than \$5.5 million out of the country, according to the U.S. Attorney's Office for New Jersey.

His guilty plea Feb. 2 came 11 days after a similar admission by a former TD Bank employee in North Jersey. Oscar Marcel Nunez-Flores, who worked for TD Bank in Scotch Plains, said he helped launder \$26 million in Colombia-bound cash, the federal prosecutor's office said.

It was the third such plea this year from former workers at Mount Laurel-based TD Bank, which has said it will spend billions to upgrade its defenses against money launderers.

Ayala, 25, and Nunez, 34, allegedly opened fraudulent bank accounts and provided debit cards to ring members. Fellow conspirators deposited money from drug proceeds in the United States, then used the debit cards to withdraw the funds from ATMs in Columbia, the prosecution said.

Breeze Airline bringing 3 new routes to Atlantic City airport

An airline that focuses on "underserved" markets has announced plans to fly from Atlantic City International Airport.
