Multiple injured and building destroyed in explosion

Four people were hospitalized in critical condition after a building explosion in Logan Township on March 4, officials said.

The incident occurred at approximately 2:36 p.m. inside the Savita Naturals building, located in the 600 block of Heron Drive near High Hill Road, a spokesperson for the Gloucester County Prosecutor's Office said at an evening press conference Wednesday outside the Municipal Building in Bridgeport.

A shelter-in-place order in Logan Township was ordered initially after the incident while workers responded on scene.

Residents within 2 miles of the area were asked to stay put at the time, with that order lifted a little before 5 p.m.

Classic South Jersey spots offer iconic menu options

South Jersey is home to a multitude of classic restaurants: from inns that have been around since the 1700s, to iconic cheesesteak spots that have been featured on television.

Take a trip to the Jersey Shore to Cape May to find some of these places, or check out Haddon Avenue in Camden — home to several iconic restaurants — to find others. The menus feature seafood, steak, pasta, soups and more.

Here are a few "classic" restaurants you may wish to try.

Braddock's Tavern, Medford

The reconstructed space — there was a devastating fire in 1843 — was once known as the Medford House Hotel and operated as an inn and hotel

through the late 1800s, its website states.

Surrounding lots and the building were purchased by Charles Braddock in 1898, and the name was soon changed to Braddock's Tavern.

Braddock's Tavern exists in a three-story clapboard building and is located along picturesque Main Street in Medford.

This colonial-style tavern and restaurant offers fireside dining, has two floors of fine dining, a charming, authentic ambiance, and a "casual gourmet" menu, a previous Courier-Post story reported. There are also two banquet facilities.

The mac and cheese at Braddock's might just be one of the stars of the show on the menu. Other menu offerings include: grilled shrimp tacos, cheesesteak egg rolls, bacon Brussels sprouts, short rib meatballs, sweet potato hummus, salads, French onion soup.

Human remains found in Middle Township woods

Human remains were found in the woods of Middle Township, authorities in Cape May County have announced.

A county resident was walking through a wooded area in Whitesboro on March 3 when they discovered what appeared to be a human skull, Cape May

County Prosecutor Jeffrey H. Sutherland said in a statement.

The resident immediately reported it to members of the Middle Township Police Department.

They then began an investigation in conjunction with other local township, county and state authorities.

After a coordinated search of the surrounding areas, officials located and recovered more skeletal remains.

They believe the remains are those of an adult human.

The person has not yet been identified.

The investigation is currently ongoing, with Sutherland asking members of the public for help.

Anyone with information regarding this investigation is asked to submit tips to the Cape May County Prosecutor's Office.

There is no threat to the public in relation to the finding, Sutherland said.
