Audit raises concerns of Amtrak role in tunnel project

Concerns about Amtrak's role in the Hudson River rail tunnel construction project, its system of tracking thousands of project documents, and a \$104 million error were among the issues raised in an audit produced by the national passenger railroad's inspector general this month.

The 32-page report was the product of an 18-month review that included work from offices in four states, visits to construction sites, reviewing more than 650 documents and interviewing over 100 people involved in the \$16 billion project to construct a new two-tube tunnel under the Hudson River and repair the existing two-track tunnel that is over 100 years old.

J.J. Marzullo, assistant inspector general of audits for Amtrak's Office of

Cop rescues dog that fell through ice into lake

A Sussex County police officer put his ice rescue training to use in saving a dog that fell into a frigid lake Dec. 17.

The Sparta Police Department received a call at 11:20 a.m. from a concerned citizen who reported the incident on Lake Mohawk, Capt. Tom Snyder said. Officers quickly arrived at the scene near Rainbow Trail, where Patrolman Michael Poon donned rescue gear to enter the water.

Body camera footage shows Poon attaching himself via a rope to another officer on shore before carefully crawling out to the area where the dog was stuck. After initially struggling to grab the dog, Poon was able to push the animal up and out onto the ice.
