Property is first of 4 slated for demolition in October

Construction crews began taking down the 737 W. Main St. building, most recently the Food Fusion Restaurant, on the morning of Oct. 1. The casual dining

Every fall, Binghamton stores stock their shelves full of Halloween candy – from everyone's favorite chocolates and sour gummies to candy corn and lolli-

Halloween spending is expected to reach a record \$13.1 billion this year, according to the National Retail Federation. Candy, which continues to be the most popular purchase, is expected to make up \$3.9 billion of the total sales.
