Harper's Corner ready to reopen

Blighted downtown area now housing and retail

The revamp of Harper's Corner is complete and ready for its grand opening after \$12.8 million and years of work.

The mixed-use development spans four buildings at the corner of Main Street and Clinton Avenue in downtown Rochester, providing 11 apartments and four commercial spaces in the formerly distressed buildings. The apartments are all occupied and three of the ground floor commercial spaces are leased out, according to Erik Frisch, commissioner of Neighborhood and Business Development for the City of Rochester.

"Harper's Corner is turning a blighted intersection into a vibrant mixed-use destination that will create new opportunities for residents, entrepreneurs and small businesses in downtown Rochester," said Gov. Kathy Hochul in a statement. "By restoring these long-vacant historic buildings and creating affordable housing and commercial space, this project is helping strengthen Rochester's urban core while preserving the architectural character that makes the city unique."

The apartments are designed for middle-income households, those earning 80% of the area median income.

The apartments include five one-bedroom units, five one-bedroom units with an office and one two-bedroom apartment. The rent on those units ranges from \$1,125 to \$1,350, based on information from the Home Leasing website.

POPE'S ENCYCLICAL ON AI WINS PRAISE

Pontiff says technology must benefit humanity

What are humans worth when the work and thoughts they produce threaten to be replicated by technological algorithms? And what is artificial intelligence worth if in the end it does not benefit humanity?

With his first major document as head of the Catholic Church, Pope Leo XIV has produced a "tremendously significant" and ultimately hopeful treatise addressing the moral questions posed by AI while stressing the need to put humans first as the rapidly developing technology progresses, church observers said.

Henrietta medical office closes temporarily after fire

A medical office in Henrietta is temporarily closed after a fire at the location.

Emergency responders were sent to the medical facility on Red Creek Drive around 8:30 a.m. May 30, when multiple smoke detectors and a water flow alarm

were activated, according to the Henrietta Fire District.

Firefighters arrived at the scene to find that the two-story building was being evacuated and smoke was visible within the building. Firefighters quickly located a fire on the first floor of the building that was "being held in check" by the building's automatic sprinkler system, firefighters said.

No injuries were reported.

"This incident serves as another reminder of the critical role automatic sprinkler systems play in protecting lives and property," Henrietta Fire District officials said in a news release.

Further details of the fire were not released.

According to the office's website, Red Creek Cardiology, 600 Red Creek Drive,

is temporarily closed. The cardiology practice is part Highland Hospital and the University of Rochester.

Appointments are being rescheduled to other locations. Anyone with an appointment who was not already contacted is asked to call (585) 341-6780.

Red Creek Drive is located south of Calkins Road in Henrietta, just east of Interstate 390 and Middle Road.
