# Berkey Trophies ends a Wayne County legacy

For 87 years, Berkey Trophies has been part of celebrations across Wayne County and beyond, marking championships, milestones and memories with plaques and trophies crafted by the Berkey family.

That era has ended, as Beth and Jesse Hamman closed the family-run business on Northeast Street in Smithville for good.

"We started thinking about it a cou-

ple of years ago," Beth Hamman said. 'My husband and I are both in our 80s. That entered into it."

Hamman's father, Wilbur Berkey, be- Hamman recalled. gan the trophy business during the Great Depression while teaching and coaching at Smithville High School. When he couldn't find a trophy to honor his county championship baseball team, he took a train to Chicago to get what he needed.

"That started a long history," she said.

Summers were spent serving county fairs across Ohio, expanding what became a family business.

"From there he branched out in the summers when he was not teaching,

# Trump-Putin bromance flowered, soured

President Donald Trump said he would end the war in Ukraine within his first 24 hours in office.

But now, more than 4,000 hours in, Trump's patience with Russian President Vladimir Putin, whom the U.S. president in June called "very kind," appears to be wearing thin.

Relations have hit a wall as Russia's leader has pushed forward with intensifying drone and missile attacks on Ukrainian cities while appearing to repeatedly rebuff Trump's attempts to broker a

"We get a lot of (expletive) thrown at us by Putin, if you want to know the truth," Trump told reporters on July 9, summing up what Ukrainians and other seasoned Russia watchers have been saying for two decades. "He's very nice to us all the time, but it turns out to be meaningless."

Trump initiated direct talks with Putin shortly after taking office, saying
