President Trump's opponents consider using Amendment 25

Provision allows VP, cabinet to declare president unable to serve

Several lawmakers are calling on President Donald Trump's Cabinet and Congress to boot him from office using a never-before-invoked provision of the Constitution.

Some Democrats, including Rep. Yassamin Ansari, D-Arizona, Sen. Ed Markey, D-Massachusetts, and Rep. Sydney Kamlager-Dove, D-California, called for invoking the 25th Amendment to remove Trump from office following news that the president sent a text to Norwegian Prime Minister Jonas Gahr Støre, saying the United States' plans to take control of Greenland stemmed from his not winning the Nobel Peace Prize.

Trump sent the text on Jan. 18, saying in part, "Considering your Country

decided not to give me the Nobel Peace Prize for having stopped 8 Wars PLUS, I no longer feel an obligation to think purely of Peace."

The text has been described as a

"last straw" for some Trump opponents, who called it an example of the president's ailing faculties.

Former Grizzly's site gets fresh start

'New chef in town' made purchase according to Facebook post

MANITOWOC – The building that most recently housed Grizzly's in Manitowoc has been sold.

The Bold Blazer Group-Keller Williams announced on Facebook a "new chef in town" recently purchased the site at 2204 Washington St.

"I can't wait to enjoy some incredible food again this spring and cocktails on the deck this summer," the post says.

We have a call out to the new owner and will fill you in as soon as we know more.

Grizzly's Food and Spirits in Manitowoc closed in July.

"It is with a heavy heart that we must inform our loyal patrons and friends that Grizzly's in Manitowoc will be permanently closed," Daryl and Trisha Jeske wrote in a Facebook post.

They said they had hoped someone would buy the business in Manitowoc, but did not have a buyer. They did not own the building.

The couple continues to own and manage Grizzly's Two Rivers location, 3312 Lincoln Ave.

The Manitowoc building is the former site of Casa di Amici, an Italian restaurant that closed in July 2021.

Staffing challenges were one of the main reasons Mark Weston, owner of the former upscale Casa di Amici, gave for closing the restaurant's doors.

Before that, the building housed the popular Tony's Pizza.

Two Rivers moves forward on harbor needs with renewed agreement

TWO RIVERS – The city of Two Rivers recently renewed an agreement with the U.S. Army Engineer District to con-

tinue using federal property near the U.S. Coast Guard post.

The property is used for a bulkhead connection at the Two Rivers Harbor.

City Manager Kyle Kordell said the city has installed some water and sewer lines in the property and has done some

landscaping as part of Harbor Park.

The agreement allows the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to complete the necessary environmental review, appraisal and legal documentation
