SpaceX to 'simplify' Starship plans

Move follows NASA's decision to consider rivals for moon mission

SpaceX, billionaire Elon Musk's commercial spaceflight company, says it's working on a "simplified" plan for its Starship megarocket to land astronauts on the moon.

The revelation, which was shared Oct. 30 in a lengthy blog post on SpaceX's website, came days after the head of NASA announced that the U.S. space agency would consider lunar lander plans from other companies. Amid a heated space race to return humans to the moon, NASA officials have expressed concern that SpaceX has fallen

Hagerstown man dies, juvenile injured when vehicle hits boulder

A Hagerstown man was pronounced dead at the scene of a one-vehicle crash on Little Antietam Road in Washington County, Maryland, Saturday evening, Nov. 1, 2025.

A juvenile passenger was flown out for treatment after the 7:26 p.m. crash.

The driver, Christopher H. Abbott, 75, was pronounced dead at the scene, the sheriff's office said.

The juvenile passenger was flown to R. Adams Cowley Shock Trauma in Baltimore for treatment of injuries suffered in the crash.

The crash occurred between Old Forge Road and Leitersburg Pike, the Leitersburg Volunteer Fire Co. reported on Facebook.

The road was closed for approximately four hours while the Washington County Crash Reconstruction Team investigated the incident, the sheriff's office said.
