Live like the Dead

Grateful Dead tribute band coming to Sioux Falls

The Grateful Dead never performed in South Dakota during its legendary 30-year career.

But the psychedelic phenomenom is not lost. Tribute band Dark Star Orchestra, who in its 25 years of music, have already performed more than 1,000 more shows than the Dead ever did. And the group will finally make a trip Sept. 2 to Sioux Falls.

Fans might not even know the difference. Dark Star Orchestra (DSO) is famed worldwide as not just a cover band but unwavering in their commitment to the sound, the spirit and the spontaneity that the playful Dead brought to shows decades

Not only does the DSO seven-piece band mimic former live shows down to the lighting and instruments used at that time, they take an audience back to each era with nostalgia and a set list that doesn't miss a note.

A look at road work this week

Welcome back to Street Smarts, your weekly go-to for understanding Sioux Falls detours and commute interruptions.

Summer is coming to an end and temperatures have been cooling down in recent weeks, but several significant projects have yet to begin.

North Drive Bridge Preservation

This \$1.5 million project began on Aug. 11, though traffic shouldn't be affected until mid-September.

ADA improvements on 41st Street and Minnesota Avenue

The multiphase project, which has no listed completion date, will include work on accessible sidewalks as well as driveway restorations and concrete curb and gutter repairs on 41st Street between Western and Westport avenues, and on Minnesota Avenue between 11th and 18th streets. Work has currently closed the outside southbound lane of Minnesota Avenue between 14th Street and 18th Street.

Traffic signal improvements on Cliff Avenue and 17th Street

This \$311,647 project may occasionally close lanes and sidewalks while work is underway. Completion is


