Burros available for adoption

DICKINSON, N.D. – Starting April 6, the Bureau of Land Management Montana/Dakotas will offer 100 burros for purchase online through its “Brayin’

Across the Dakotas” event.

The animals, according to the Bureau of Land Management release, both jennies and geldings of various ages, will be available for purchase on the Fixed Price Online Corral at noon April 6 through noon April 13, or until all burros are sold.

They are currently available to view online.

Each burro will be sold for \$125 on a first-come, first-served basis, the BLM stated in a release. Buyers must fill out an online form and be approved for purchase. Successful buyers may pick up

their burro on May 30 in Richardton or Jamestown, North Dakota or Belle Fourche, South Dakota.

Initiative offers caregivers daytime support

The Village of Harmony Hill has launched an adult day services program to support older adults and provide respite for caregivers, according to a community announcement.

The program, located in the secure memory care neighborhood of Hope Terrace, offers a structured day filled with engagement, social connection and professional care.

Participants will have access to specialized programming, nutritious meals and snacks, registered nurse support, medication assistance and a secure memory garden. Additional care services, such as bathing and nail care, are also available.

The program operates from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday, offering flex-

ibility for caregivers and participants. An hourly rate is available with no long-term commitment required.

“At the Village of Harmony Hill, our Adult Day Service Program is designed to nurture connection, purpose and well-being,” Kelsey Belle Kohler, memory care manager, said in a release. “Participants enjoy enriching cognitive activities, intergenerational experiences and community outings

Falls Park a perfect day trip destination

As Sioux Falls’ namesake, Falls Park is known as “the heart of the city” along the Big Sioux River. Folks stop by for family photos, first dates and picnics by the waterfall. It’s as romantic as it is nostalgic and has brought a huge bump in tourism for the east side of the state.

As part of a USA TODAY Network project exploring places across America with historical and cultural significance, and as a celebration of the nation’s 250th birthday, here’s a look at why Falls Park makes an ideal day trip or staycation pit stop.

Location

131 E. Falls Park Drive in Sioux Falls, South Dakota.

Why it matters

Before it was 120 acres of rest, recreation and one of the best photo-ops in South Dakota, Falls Park was a trading hub for Dakota and Lakota tribes as late as the 1800s until it drew in settlers as an industrial site.

It failed as a grain milling powerhouse due to short water supply, then transformed into a hydroelectric power plant for a short while.

Now as a city-run park for over a century, it is historically preserved to welcome over one million visitors a year.

What to see

Take it all in atop the park’s five-story viewing tower, providing a picturesque, panoramic view of Sioux Falls, especially nice at dusk.
