DNR reveals details of fatal Devil's Lake fall

The details of what led to the fatal fall and death of 30-year-old climbing guide Audrie Pelosi in May at Devil's Lake State Park have been released by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. Pelosi died after falling approximately 150 feet from the Hawk's Nest climbing area on the park's east bluff while setting up equipment for a top-rope climb, according to a DNR investigation report.

Pelosi died while setting up climbs for clients

On May 30, Pelosi and two other employees of Apex Adventure Alliance were preparing several climbs for a group of clients who were on their way to the park. Pelosi and her two coworkers were setting anchors for top-rope climbing. Pelosi was working near a tree she planned to use as an anchor while her coworkers were setting anchors farther east. The two coworkers were on the opposite side of a large rock outcropping, which prevented them from seeing or communicating with Pelosi while they worked. Neither coworker witnessed Pelosi fall. After the coworkers finished setting their anchors, they returned to where Pelosi had been working and discovered she was gone. They yelled for her several times but received no response. The two descended the bluff using a trail east of their location and found Pelosi lying unresponsive below the rock wall. One of the coworkers called 911 and stayed with Pelosi while the

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CA man charged in killing of kidnapped businessman

A Southern California man has been charged in the killing of a businessman whom authorities believe was abducted

from outside his home and fatally shot in the trunk of a car moments after a police chase. The San Bernardino County District Attorney's Office on Aug. 3 charged Jianquan Bo, 66, with murder in the

death of 60-year-old Shukur Aikebaer, who is believed to be a former business associate of Bo's older brother. “This was a calculated act of violence,” San Bernardino County Sheriff Shannon Dicus said at a news confer-

ence on Aug. 3. Bo was arraigned on Aug. 4 and pleaded not guilty. He remained in custody without bail, according to the sheriff's See CHARGED, Page 6A



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
