### Amid war, Ukrainian surgeons learn how to reconstruct limbs at UW

### Closure of Main Street bridge for repairs postponed

Department of Public Works cites 'unforeseen circumstances'

A closure of the Main Street bridge scheduled for June 1 has been postponed "due to unforeseen circumstances," according to a news release from the Department of Public Works.

The bridge will be closed June 4-25, the department said in its release, updating a previously announced 19-day closure that'd been set to start June 1.

Trista Hobbs, a facilities manager, did not immediately respond to a question from the Green Bay Press-Gazette to clarify the unforeseen circumstances.

Lunda Construction will repair the bridge's counterweights as part of a \$14 million contract to fix its aging infrastructure.

## Wisconsin UTV riders must wear seat belts under new law

A new law in Wisconsin that took effect June 1 requires all UTV drivers and passengers to wear seat belts.

The new requirement is one of a handful of law changes for ATV and UTV riders in Wisconsin, according to the state Department of Natural Resources.

Here's what to know about the new laws taking effect.

#### What are Wisconsin's new ATV and UTV laws?

There are several changes detailed in the DNR's 2026 ATV/UTV regulations:

- Drivers and passengers need to wear seatbelts in UTVs.
- Someone damaging property on purpose can be fined up to three times the cost of the repairs to the damage.

- ATVs and UTVs can't tow anything with a person on it if they are on a trail or route. Towing people on ice is allowed, but the speed limit is 10 mph.
- UTVs have window tint restrictions.

#### Can I drive an ATV or UTV on the streets?

You're not allowed to operate an ATV on any freeway and most roads in Wisconsin, though there are some exceptions for agricultural purposes. There are also exceptions for races and derbies.

#### How many people have died in ATV and UTV crashes in 2026?

There have been 15 deaths as of June 1, according to the DNR. Many of the
