New hemp rules could threaten businesses

President Donald Trump has officially signed into law new federal hemp regulations that will ban the sale of most THC products nationwide, including in Wisconsin. The hemp laws were signed late Nov. 12 as part of the sweeping funding bill that ended the record 43-day government shutdown Wednesday. When enacted, the regulations could force hundreds of dispensaries, smoke shops and cannabis bars across Wisconsin to close. Here's what to know about the new federal hemp laws and how they may affect Wisconsin businesses:
