Plover seeks input on road improvements

PLOVER – The Village of Plover will host a public information meeting Sept. 10 to gather input on potential road improvement projects in the Pines Corporate Centre area. The meeting will take place from 4-6 p.m. at the Plover Municipal Center, 2400 Post Road, according to a community announcement.

With ongoing manufacturing growth in the industrial park, the village recently completed a Traffic Impact Analysis to identify necessary road improvements. The analysis suggests two main projects: the potential realignment of Corporate Avenue to connect with River Drive and the future signalization of the intersection of State 54 and Foremost Road.

The Traffic Impact Analysis is available for review on the Village of Plover website under Government > Community Development > Planning.

The meeting will be conducted in an open-house format, allowing attendees to view project concepts, ask questions and provide feedback. Residents, business owners and other interested parties are encouraged to participate. Public feedback will be compiled and presented to the Village Board for future consideration.

STEVENS POINT – A new clinic that will help meet the growing demand for ear, nose and throat, allergy, immunology and audiology care in central Wisconsin is now open in Stevens Point.

ENT & Allergy Associates opened its new Stevens Point office Sept. 2 at 5509 Vern Holmes Drive, according to a news release from the clinic.

The clinic also offers walk-in care, providing easy access to specialty care

for ear infections, sore throats, sinus issues and more concerns, providing "high-quality care more accessible to those with acute issues or busy schedules" without needing an appointment, according to the release.

Dr. Jessica Weddle with ENT & Allergy Associates said the new building demonstrates commitment to the community that the practice has been part of for more than 20 years.

She said the new facility allows providers to serve and treat patients five days a week with immediate walk-in access.

"We look forward to welcoming our established patients into our new space and meeting many new faces throughout the community," Weddle said.

"It is an exciting time for us, and we are grateful for the continued support from those in the Stevens Point area and surrounding communities."

The new standalone clinic is open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Mondays through Fridays, and the walk-in clinic is open from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Mondays through Fridays.

ENT & Allergy Associates an-

nounced in November its plan to expand to serve the Stevens Point community and announced its plans to open the clinic late this summer. The 10,700-square-foot Stevens Point clinic was modeled after its Wausau location that was designed and built in 2019. The Stevens Point location is smaller than the Wausau site and tailored to the Stevens Point community.
