For nearly 20 years now, she has been making the drive up from Manitowoc to pass out her cookies to players as they make their way back to Lambeau Field after practice. "The Cookie Lady," as she's been dubbed, is a training camp veteran. She seldom misses a day, and she comes prepared.

She has her cookies individually bagged, on ice in a cooler with an umbrella during the steamy summer days, and a smile that makes indulging hard to resist.

"You know you're making it difficult for me to stick to my diet," safety Evan Williams told her as he took some on a recent August training camp day.
